Training Program

Our training program prepares graduate students to work with historically underrepresented populations, namely the LGBTQ+ community. Our overarching training model is developmental in nature, offering supervision from a variety of theoretical orientations and working with students to ensure confident and ethical practice. Students will gain experience working with various presenting concerns, and will be able to tailor their clinical experience to continued areas of growth and/or professional interests.

Qualifications

Materials will be considered for those applicants who:

- Have at least two semesters of supervised clinical work that provided experience working with marginalized and historically underrepresented populations AND crisis management
- Have an ability to integrate advocacy and social justice principles into clinical practice
- Are in good academic standing with their home program

Preference will be given to candidates who:

- Have experience working specifically with LGBTQIA+ populations
- Hold marginalized identities
- Have 3 semesters of clinical experience or more
