- Conduct diagnostic interviews and psychological testing, write reports, participate in case conferences
- Gain skills in test selection, administration, scoring, interpretation, and communicating results
- Learn/practice evaluating cognitive functioning, attention, memory, learning, adaptive skills, behavior, temperament/personality, and emotional functioning from **toddlerhood through adolescence**
- Interact with multidisciplinary teams including child & adolescent psychologists, psychiatrists, speechlanguage pathologists, occupational therapists, social workers, and more
- Participate in weekly continuing education seminars
