Summer semesters at Loyola University Maryland are considered optional semesters of study. Please note that institutional funds are not available for use during the summer term. However, financial assistance can still be accessed through various loan programs.

If you're considering summer courses, you can utilize the Federal Direct Parent (PLUS) loan or explore private alternative education loan programs to cover your expenses.

- For those eligible for Federal Pell Grants, there's good news: you may be able to use these funds for summer courses if you meet specific criteria. To qualify, you must have received the Federal Pell Grant previously and have enrolled in a minimum of 24 credits over the prior fall and spring semesters. Additionally, you need to be enrolled in at least two classes (equivalent to at least six credits) during the summer term to qualify for the Federal Pell Grant and/or the Federal Direct Parent (PLUS) loan.
