



Students who:

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- <u>Apply online</u> now through **11:59pm on** September 19
- Include 3 references to be contacted by OIP staff
- Participate in an interview with a program director (Madison or Kim)



THE APPLICATION PROCESS



- This program has a maximum capacity of 20 participants
- Our goal is to have a student cohort that mirrors the diverse student demographics of the class of 2028
- All completed applications submitted by **11:59pm on September 19** will be considered
- Final acceptances will be based on your application responses, recommendations and interview
- Acceptance notifications will be sent during the third week of September.



PASSPORTS

Students in this program must have a passport that does not expire before **July 10, 2025**. If you plan to participate in any LUM study abroad program in 2025 and your passport is not valid for at least 6 months past the return date, start the passport renewal process NOW!





PASSPORTS



 The US state department is currently quoting <u>passport</u> <u>processing times</u> of 6-8 weeks for routine processing (\$130) and 2-3 weeks for expedited processing (additional fee of \$60)

PROGRAM FEES

\$3,400 per student paid directly to Loyola University Maryland

- Round trip airfare
- Hotel accommodations
- Entrance & activity fees
- Private transportation
- Local guides for duration of the program
- Some group meals

*Students may be eligible for up to \$2,000 reduction in the program fee based on financial need and additional scholarship opportunities are possible for qualifying students, more details will be sent with student acceptance letters.





ACCEPTED STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- Participate in all workshops and pre-departure meetings (at least one/month starting in September).
- Remain in good academic and disciplinary standing. Conduct violations may result in dismissal from the program and student liability for any un-recoverable costs paid on their behalf.





Q. What are the different types of housing available during the program?

A. Students will share a double occupancy hotel room during the program.

Q. How would this program impact my courses?

A. This program is over the winter break; you will be back on campus before the start of the spring semester.

Q. Are there any costs we should expect that are not covered by the program fee? **A. Students will be responsible for the cost of lunches and some dinners on this program, in addition to any personal spending money for shopping or free-time activities.**

Q. Are their any pre-requisites (outside of being a first-year student) to be considered for this program?

A. Students will be considered for this program based on their application responses, interview and references.

Q. Will this itinerary change at all?

A. WorldStrides reserves the flexibility to make changes to an itinerary if necessary. In the case of removing an activity, alternate activities will be substituted.
