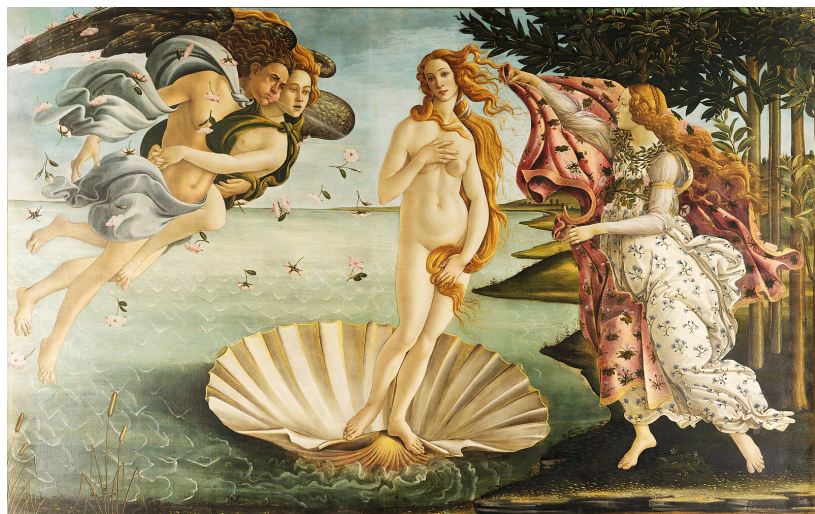


NEW MAYMESTER

DATES: May 20-June 9 (3 weeks). Online classes May 20-24. Depart for Italy on Sunday, May 26 and return to USA on Sunday, June 9. 13 nights in Italy.

COURSE: AH111- Western Art: Renaissance to Contemporary (3 credits). Fulfills the Fine Arts core requirement. May be taken as a free elective. Instructor: Prof. Kerry Boeye.

PROGRAM FEE: \$3,950 (airfare not included). Fee includes tuition, housing, breakfasts, some special meals, all transportation in Italy, entrance to museums/sites, guided tours, and group activities.
