## **REQUIRED:** STUDENT HEALTH PROFILE

The Student Health Profile is required for **all undergraduate**, **graduate**, **and transfer students** entering Loyola University. There are several parts to the profile that must be completed to be compliant with this requirement.

### **DEADLINE:** JULY 1<sup>ST</sup> FOR FALL ENTRANCE | JANUARY 3<sup>RD</sup> FOR SPRING ENTRANCE

## The Student Health Profile is to be completed online by visiting: www.lovola.edu/patientportal

Please note: We recommend using Google Chrome to complete the profile.

\*\*You will not be able to complete this profile until you are issued your Loyola University username and password\*\* If you have problems logging in, contact Tech Services at 410-617-5555.

Log in using your Loyola University-issued username and password and complete each section of the Student Health Profile by following the steps listed below.

#### 1. Under the FORMS tab:

- a. Student Health History
- b. Consent for Treatment

#### 2. Under the UPLOAD tab:\*→

- a. Upload Immunization records/lab results for titers
- b. Upload photo of Insurance card (front & back)

#### 3. Under the IMMUNIZATIONS tab:

a. Use the drop-down menus to enter the dates when you received the vaccines required by the university (*See page 2 for a list of required vaccinations*).

\*Make sure you have uploaded a copy of your official immunization records from your doctor or titer bloodwork results through the "Upload" tab – Our staff cannot verify your vaccines without this step.

#### 4. Under the INSURANCE tab: \*Required for full-time students only\*

a. Go to <u>https://rcmdstudentbenefits.com/loyolauniversitymd/</u> to enroll or waive coverage in the Student Health Insurance Plan.

#### **ATTN GRADUATE STUDENTS:**

- The health profile is required for ALL graduate students regardless of full-time or part-time status. Students in programs with classes that are **STRICTLY ONLINE** must complete the *Student Health History* form but are not required to comply with immunization requirements.
- Students who have already completed these requirements as a Loyola undergraduate student do not need to submit another health profile but should ensure all vaccinations are up to date.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

- These health requirements are SEPARATE from any requirements for other programs such as Athletics or Sports Medicine. The information submitted is NOT shared between departments.
- Students with documented disabilities should register with Disability & Accessibility Services at (410) 617-2750 to ensure their specific academic, residential, and/or dining needs will be addressed during their time at Loyola. - Student Health Services will not contact you after you submit all the above information unless there is an issue, or you are missing a piece of your Student Health Profile. # Immunizations required of <u>ALL</u> Loyola University Students

REQUIRED VACCINE	TIMING/ADDITIONAL INFO
<b>MMR</b> (Measles, Mumps, & Rubella)	2 doses - the first dose must be <b>AFTER</b> the student's 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday or Lab test ( <i>Titers)</i> results proving immunity
	* <b>GRADUATE STUDENTS</b> born after 1957 are exempt from this requirement*
<b>Meningitis</b> MCV4/ACYW [Menactra/Menveo/MenQuadfi]	The most recent dose must be <b>AFTER</b> the student's 16 <sup>th</sup> birthday and within the last 5 years.
	*GRADUATE STUDENTS age 22 and older who are not living on campus are exempt from this requirement*
<b>Tdap</b> (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) <i>[Adacel/Boostrix]</i>	Most recent dose within the last 10 years
<b>Tuberculosis Screening Questionnaire</b> (completed as part of the Student Health History)	If you have answered yes to any of the questions, you will need to have a Tuberculosis Skin Test (PPD) or the Quantiferon Gold/T-spot (lab test) done.

# **STRONGLY Recommended Immunizations**

These immunizations are STRONGLY recommended, although they are not required for admission.

Covid-19 Vaccine	At least one bivalent mRNA COVID-19 vaccine (as recommended by the CDC)
Seasonal Influenza Vaccine	Received annually, preferably in October

### **CHECK THE STATUS OF YOUR HEALTH PROFILE**

Click on the "Immunizations" section. The checklist on the right-hand side indicates any missing items in Red

-Not Compliant = You are missing components to your health profile.
-Compliant = You have submitted all the components, but they have not yet been verified by our staff.
-Verified = The dates and documentation have been verified by our staff and your Health Profile is complete.
